for all training activities

You will comply at all times with the instructions of the skipper of the boat particularly with regard to instructions for boarding and leaving the boat, using the equipment on the boat, handling sails and the wearing of a buoyancy aid;

You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence.

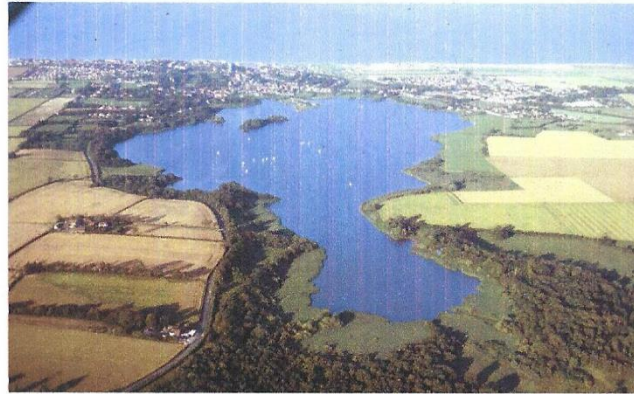
